ORDINANCE NO. 3-92

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4-80,  
AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NOS. 1-84 AND 1-88

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE GROVELAND  
COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT, as follows:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 4-80, as amended by Ordinance No.  
1-84 and 1-88, is amended as follows: The last paragraph of  
SECTION 5 is amended to read as follows:

"No permit shall be issued until the applicant has  
supplied the District with a copy of an insurance binder  
evidencing public liability and property damage insurance  
coverage for the event with liability limits of not less  
than \$300,000.00 per person and \$1,000,000.00 per  
occurrence, and property damage limits of not less than  
\$100,000.00 per occurrence with an aggregate coverage of  
\$200,000.00. If alcoholic beverages are to be served or  
sold by a permittee, the liability limit per person shall  
be \$500,000.00."


SECTION 2: The Ordinance shall take effect and be in full  
force from and after the date of its final passage, and before the  
expiration of 15 days after its final passage, it shall be posted  
in three public places, and for not less than 30 days within the  
Groveland Community Services District.


The foregoing Ordinance was introduced at a regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the Groveland Community Services District held on August 11, 1992, and given a first reading at said meeting.
