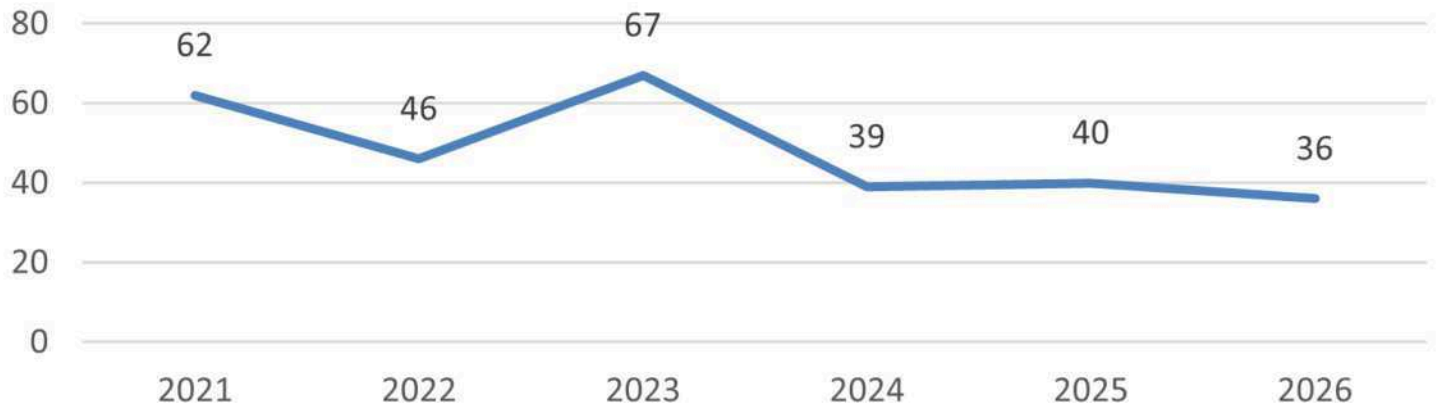

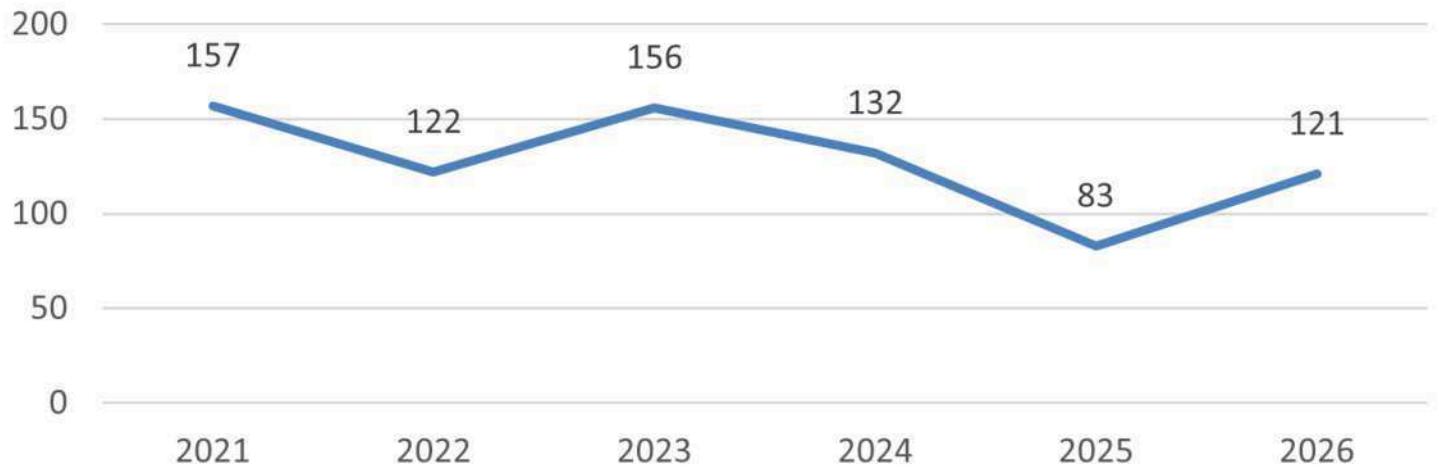

Tamarron Incident

On Sunday, March 8th at approximately 4 PM, GCSD E781, TCFD E761, and TCFD E511 was dispatched to a residential structure fire in the Mono Village area at Tamarron Mobile Home Park while at Station 51 in East Sonora for monthly training.

E761 arrived on scene and reported a single-story mobile home with a working fire. Due to the quick and coordinated efforts of all responding agencies crews were able to quickly knock down the fire and prevent it from spreading further throughout the structure.
