

Honoring Mary Laveroni

Mr. Speaker, I rise today to recognize Mary Laveroni for her 50 years of service with Groveland Community Service District and her other contributions to the community of Groveland. She will be honored at a ceremony on August 19th to dedicate Groveland's Wayside Park as Mary Laveroni Community Park.

Laveroni has shown continuous involvement and commitment to the Groveland community. She was one of three founding directors who formed the Groveland Community Service District in 1953 to address the area's water problems. She served on its board for a total of 26 years, 18 as Board President. Along with fellow board members, Laveroni helped secure a reliable and low cost water supply from San Francisco's Hetch Hetchy project. Today, the Groveland Community Service District handles not only the area's water needs by providing wastewater collection and treatment, but also park maintenance, fire and rescue and other vital services to the community.

Laveroni's contributions to her community go beyond the formation of the services district. Mary is responsible for donating the land and financing the construction of the Groveland Medical Clinic. She also served for 17 years in the U.S. Forest Service.

Mr. Speaker, I rise today to recognize Mary Laveroni for her contributions to the Groveland community. I invite my colleagues to join me in honoring Mary for her continual service and years of dedication.
