RESOLUTION 10-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE GROVELAND COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS ACCEPTING THE FINAL ENGINEER'S REPORT AND ESTABLISHING THE FIRE SUPPRESSION AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE SERVICES DISTRICT FOR THE GROVELAND COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 50078 et. seq. provides that the Board of Directors of the Groveland Community Services District ("District") may determine and levy an assessment for the purposes of obtaining, furnishing, operating, and maintaining fire suppression equipment or apparatus or for the purpose of paying the salaries and benefits of firefighting personnel, or both; and

WHEREAS, on November 5, 1996, California voters approved Proposition 218, entitled "Right to Vote on Taxes Act," which added Articles XIIIIC and XIIIID to the California Constitution ("Proposition 218") which established procedural requirements for the formation and administration of assessment districts; and

WHEREAS, on February 11, 2002, the GCS D Board of Directors approved Resolution 3-02 initiating proceedings for the formation of a fire suppression and emergency response services District for the Groveland Community Services District, retaining Bartle Wells Associates to prepare an Engineer's Report pursuant to Article XIIIID of the California Constitution and in accordance with Government Code Section 50078 et. Seq.; and

WHEREAS, on April 8, 2002, the GCS D Board of Directors approved Resolution 6-02 accepting the Preliminary Engineer's Report, authorizing conducting an assessment ballot proceeding, and setting the time and place of a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, public hearing notices and assessment ballots were duly and regularly mailed on April 24, 2002 in the time, form and manner required by Resolution 6-02 and Resolution No. 7-02 and the GCS D Board of Directors held a public hearing on June 12, 2002 that was conducted according to the procedures in Resolution No. 6-02 and Resolution No. 7-02, and

WHEREAS, The GCS D Board of Directors Approved Resolution 9-02 on June 24, 2002, accepting the results of the Ballots cast and determining a majority of the property owners voted to establish the Big Oak Flat - Groveland Fire and Rescue Assessment District

WHEREAS, Bartle Wells Associates have filed with the Board of Directors of the Groveland Community Services District, a Final

Engineer's Report which contains: (a) a calculation of the portion of the services to be provided by the Assessment District that constitute a special benefit to the parcels in the District; (b) a methodology for assigning fire suppression assessments to individual parcels; (c) a listing of each lot or parcel of property that would be subject to the proposed fire suppression assessment including public parcels; (d) the amount of the proposed assessment for each lot or parcel for the 2002/2003 fiscal year; and (e) an assessment diagram depicting the boundary of the Assessment district.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Groveland Community Services District Board of Directors as follows:

Section One. The above recitals are true and correct.

Section Two. The Board of Directors of Groveland Community Services District, County of Tuolumne, State of California, hereby receives and accepts and authorizes the Board Clerk to File the Final Engineer's Report.

Section Three. The Groveland Community Fire Suppression and Emergency Response Services District shall be established for purposes of obtaining, furnishing, operating, and maintaining fire suppression equipment or apparatus or for the purpose of paying the salaries and benefits of firefighting personnel, or both, whether or not fire suppression services are actually used by or upon a parcel, improvement, or property.

Section Four. Funds collected from the Groveland Community Fire Suppression and Emergency Response Services District shall be expended only for the special benefit of parcels within the Groveland Community Services District Boundaries as defined by the assessment diagram included with the Final Engineer's Report. Any unexpended funds raised by the Assessment remaining at the end of any fiscal year shall be carried over to be utilized for the same purposes in the next fiscal year.

Section Five. The Groveland Community Fire Suppression and Emergency Response Services District assessments shall be collected in the same manner, and subject to the same penalties as property taxes in Tuolumne County.


