A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF GROVELAND COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT PROVIDING FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF THE WALKING TRAIL TO BE CONSTRUCTED UNDER THE GROVELAND PARK CORRIDOR PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Groveland Community Services District wishes to construct an Interpretive Walking and Biking Trail to connect Mary Laveroni Community Park and Leo Rose Ball Field, and

WHEREAS, a request for a Federal Transportation Enhancement Grant for the Interpretive Walking and Biking Trail has been submitted, and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Transportation has determined that the Interpretive Trail Project is eligible for Transportation Enhancement funding, and

WHEREAS, Groveland Community Services District will be the Administering Agency for the Interpretive Trail Project, and

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration requires that the Administering Agency certify that it is willing and able to maintain and operate the project under consideration.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of Groveland Community Services District that the District will maintain and operate the Interpretive Walking and Biking Trail for the life of the facility.
