ABOUT US

The Groveland Community Services District (GCSD) is a Special District formed by the State of California. GCSD is a multi-purpose special district providing water, sewer, fire, and park services. The GCSD service area covers approximately 15 square miles in southern Tuolumne County. The District is bounded on the north by the Tuolumne River, on the south by Mariposa County, on the east by the Stanislaus National Forest, and on the west by Moccasin. GCSD is the owner and operator of the Groveland Water System, which receives water from the City and County of San Francisco's Hetch Hetchy water system.

GCSD's Water System distributes treated water to the populated areas of Big Oak Flat, Groveland, and Pine Mountain Lake. The GCSD water supply and distribution system includes three water treatment plants, five storage reservoirs, and approximately 70 miles of distribution piping. The District provides a treated water supply to approximately 3,500 customers. The District also owns and operates the regional wastewater collection, treatment, and regional recycled water system, which provides sewer service to approximately 1,500 customers within the District's service area.

THE COMMUNITY

Located 145 miles East of San Francisco and 25 miles from Yosemite National Park, Groveland is a quaint town in the heart of Gold Country. Groveland has a rich history with the California Gold Rush and the Hetch Hetchy Railroad. The town served as the headquarters for the railroad as it transported supplies to the O'Shaughnessy Dam and the Hetch Hetchy Reservoir.



Although Groveland has a population of approximately 3,000 full-time residents, this number often triples during the summer months. Groveland has a charming downtown and is home to the Pine Mountain Lake community, which offers a golf course, equestrian center, and a private lake. Groveland borders the Stanislaus National Forest, which boasts many beautiful hiking and biking trails, lakes and rivers, white water rafting, fishing, and campgrounds.

GCSD fosters strong relationships with the community we serve through public outreach, educational initiatives, and public involvement opportunities. Engaging with residents, businesses, schools, and local government agencies, helps build trust and support.

In the last five years, GCSD has been awarded over \$25,914,000 in State and Federal grants for various projects that improve infrastructure, enhance public services, and ensure the well-being of our community. These projects include hundreds of acres of fuels reduction, sewer collection system upgrades and rehab, water system improvements, replacement of standby emergency generators, and rehab and beautification of our parks.

CORE DUTIES

- Compiles and submits monthly, quarterly, and annual reports for regulatory agencies. Maintains systems Regulatory Compliance.
- Operate SCADA computer equipment to control and monitor flow of water and/or wastewater treatment and processing chemicals through the treatment plant and water distribution system; monitor gauges, meters, and record meter readings; maintain shift log.
- Observe variations in operating conditions; interpret computer, meter, and gauge readings; check, standardize, and calibrate instruments, analyzers, and chemical feed pumps; start and stop.
- Makes regular assessments of water flow, turbidity, pressure, chemical use, residuals, and other pertinent data to maintain proper plant operating conditions, electric driven pumps, and motors to control and adjust flow and treatment processes.
- Manages logs, records, and data systems for required plant reports; assists with the preparation and updating of reports for Regional, State, and Federal regulatory agencies.
- Consults with District Engineers on detailed planning, analysis, and design processes required to enhance or expand existing infrastructure systems.
- Supervision and training of WWTO I/II/III staff members.
