A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE GROVELAND COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT COMMENDING DIRECTOR SPENCER EDWARDS FOR HIS EFFORTS AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS WHILE SERVING THE GROVELAND COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Spencer Edwards has been a dedicated member of the Groveland community for 39 years, including 9 years of employment with the District beginning in 1992, and service as a volunteer firefighter with the Groveland CSD Fire Department. He also honorably served twenty years of active duty in the United States Army; and

WHEREAS, in 2017, Spencer Edwards was appointed as if elected to serve on the Board of Directors of the Groveland Community Services; and
