

GCSD Phase II Drought

Declaration Restrictions

In Response to the State's actions, The Groveland Community Services District Board of Directors has declared a Phase II Drought Declaration on May 26, 2016. The District has asked for a **Voluntary 20%** reduction of water consumption compared to water use in 2014. Below is a list of restrictions that are currently in place:

- Restaurants shall only serve water on request
- Washing of sidewalks, walkways, driveways, patios, graveled areas, tennis courts, or other hard-surface areas, including residential and commercial establishments, by hose or by use of water from faucets or other outlets connected to the public water supply is prohibited.
- Fire hydrant flow testing is prohibited.
- Washing of automobiles with hoses not equipped with shut-off nozzels.
- Watering of lawns and/or landscaping that causes runoff, or within 48 hours after measurable precipitation.
