RESOLUTION 8-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE GROVELAND COMMUNITY
SERVICES BOARD OF DIRECTORS ADOPTING CONTINUING
PROCEEDINGS FOR THE FIRE SUPPRESSION AND EMERGENCY
RESPONSE SERVICES DISTRICT FOR THE GROVELAND COMMUNITY
SERVICES DISTRICT

WHEREAS, on February 11, 2002 the Board of Directors of the Groveland Community Services District ("District") adopted Resolution 3-02 proposing the formation of a fire suppression and emergency response services district ("Assessment District") pursuant to California Codes Government Code Sections 50078 et.seq. and Article XIIIID of the California Constitution; and

WHEREAS on April 8, 2002 the District adopted Resolution 6-02 accepting the preliminary engineer's report, authorizing conducting an assessment ballot proceeding, and setting the time and place of a public hearing to consider the establishment of a fire suppression district and emergency response for the District.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors believes it to be in the best interest of the Groveland Community Services District to establish provisions relating to the continuation of the fees for the proposed fire suppression and emergency response services district.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the Groveland Community Services District that:


1. In each subsequent year for which the assessments will be levied, the Board will designate an Engineer of Work and order the to preparation of an Engineer's Report in accordance with Article 4 of Chapter 1 of the Act and Article XIIIID of the California Constitution (the "Article") and California Government Code Sections 50078 et.seq (the "Code"). Upon completion, the Engineer shall file the Engineer's Report with the

Clerk of the Board for submission to the Board.

2. As required by the Article, the Engineer's Report will detail budgets, including the level of District contribution of unpledged property tax revenue and proposed assessments for the upcoming fiscal year.
3. The Board shall adopt by Resolution each year accepting the Engineer's Report and call for a Public Hearing and publish a legal notice of the assessment Public Hearing at least 10 days prior to the date of the Public Hearing
4. Following consideration of all public comments and any written protests at a noticed public hearing, and review of the Final Engineer 's Report, the Board may order amendments to the Report or confirm the Report as submitted.
5. Following final approval of the Report, and confirmation of the assessments, the Board may, by resolution, order the levy and collection of assessments for the subsequent fiscal year. In such case, the assessment information will be submitted to the County Auditor/Controller, and included on the property tax roll for each parcel
